BIO

Hagai Izenberg is a sound artist, composer and musician and a founder member of the electronic duo Rendezvous. Based in Israel, born in 1978.

His experimental work focuses on sounds we are exposed to every day in the public and domestic spheres, often in passing or involuntary.

He collects, edits and manipulates field recordings, objects, circuit bent toys and a variety of live sources such as radio, tv and other streaming sources (for example police dispatch)

With these sounds objects and origins he builds multi-layered compositions (live in realtime) of today's mixed reality.

Hagai performs regularly in Israel and in Europe, playing live in festivals, art and music events and doing sound installations. His pieces are played in radio shows such as Late Junction (BBC 3), Framework radio, Radiophrenia and more.

He also produces a radio art show called Radio Concrete on Resonance Extra (UK), WGXC (NY), Radio Papesse and does other radio-art works (106fm, Radiophrenia Ouïedire and more)
